

From the Pastor – May 2020

Why is all this happening? All around the world people are suffering from the effects of COVID-19. Some are suffering the loss of loved ones. Some are suffering physically from the disease itself. All of us are suffering from the economic and personal effects of sheltering in place. An almost universal response to suffering is to ask, "Why?" Some people try to answer the "why" of COVID-19 by blaming someone or some group for negligence or even for elaborate conspiracies. But others take the question higher, and wonder why God allows this to happen (or even cause) this to happen.

In response to this question I would like to share an excerpt from a letter by Dr. Timothy Tennent, the president of Asbury Theological Seminary (where Kathy and I were students). He writes:

"All sin traces back to the free will decisions made by Adam and Eve, and we continue to affirm their rebellion through our own sinful acts. Paul teaches that sin came into the world through the Fall, and our subsequent joining in that rebellion has "subjected the world to bondage" and that 'the whole creation is groaning . . . up until the present time: (Romans 8:20-22). If it were not for sin, there would not be murders, terrorists, viruses, or any other signs that we live in a broken world."

"God's answer to the problem of evil is not to give us some amazing theological resolution or an intricate philosophical formula but rather to enter into the world not in power but in weakness and vulnerability. This is how God addresses the root of this problem – us. We are in rebellion against God and the whole world is reeling. Jesus alone has taken on all this sin and pain. To look into the face of the crucified Jesus is to understand the heart of God. The cross is God's answer to human pain. He doesn't give us an answer – he bears the pain for us."

We have just celebrated Good Friday and Easter. We have looked into the face of Jesus on the cross and shared the excitement of the resurrection. God doesn't always give us answers to our questions, but He answers our need. He is our answer. May we find all we need in Him.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**Q-When will the church reopen?**

**A-**We don't know yet. We are relying on guidance from health officials and conference leadership. We may "open" gradually.

**Q-What about Vacation Bible School?**

**A-**We will not be having a regular VBS this year. Even if it were permitted, it probably would not be a good idea to cram 250+ kids and staff into the sanctuary and classrooms. We are looking at some kind of at-home alternative for this year (I know, it just won't be the same without the hugs).

**Q-What about the finances of the church?**

**A-**Money is frequently tight anyway, and income is down from regular Sunday offerings and from rental fees from groups that use the facilities. Your faithful giving through the mail or online is vitally important at this time. We have applied for a grant through the Payroll Protection Plan that would help offset some of this shortfall, but there is no guarantee we will receive these funds. We are continuing to pay all of our employees. At least our utility bills should be lower!

**This Message Just came in from the Bishop of The United Methodist Church:**

**Bishop Directs Church Buildings to Remain Closed Through May**

The following is taken from a message from our bishop, Minerva Carcaño:

While we continue the sacred work we are called to, it is clear that we must do so with our California-Nevada church buildings closed. Not our ministries stopped, but our buildings closed. After careful analysis of virus reports from state and local government and public health officials in Nevada and California, I am directing California-Nevada churches to remain closed throughout the month of May. Our conference staff team will also continue to shelter in place and work remotely from home.

We will continue to monitor the virus trends and data in the coming weeks and make another assessment of sheltering in place at the end of May.



