## From the Pastor

We are excited to be able to hold in-person worship again. For the past two weeks we have had worship on the lawn, chairs well-spaced, and everyone wearing masks.

We will continue posting the services online, but they may not be ready until Sunday afternoon or Monday, since we record them on Sunday morning.

Dos Palos UMC is going to have an outdoor worship service Saturday, September 12<sup>th</sup> at 8:30am. We will serve communion at Dos Palos on the 12<sup>th</sup>.

We will serve communion at the Los Banos United Methodist Church on September 6<sup>th</sup> service on the lawn.

I confess that my mind has lately been occupied with all the logistics of worship – How will we do the sound system? How will the people enter? How can we distribute communion? How will we post it online? How can we make sure we are not spreading the coronavirus? But while all these issues are important, they are not the core of what is important about worship. What is most important is what God thinks about our worship. I believe these three questions are how God evaluates our worship: Did you seek me? Did you respond to my love and my call? Did your worship change you in a way that still shows on Monday? Whether we worship online or in-person, indoors or out, alone or with thousands; may your worship be a life-giving and life-changing encounter with God.

## **Administrative Council Highlights – August 4, 2020**

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, August 4, 2020 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Susan Ramsey was elected to serve as Chairperson of the SPRC.
- **Church Re-Opening.** Our approved plan re-launch in-person services on July 19 was canceled when the State subsequently prohibited indoor worship services in Merced County, due to large increases in COVID-19 cases. Outdoor services are okay, subject to some conditions, so the Re-Launch Committee was to meet on August 12 to make plans. We will continue to videotape and post the services online, and hopefully can livestream services whenever they commence.

An outdoor memorial service for Suzanne Kosters was to be held on August 22. Due to the shutdown, we will be refunding a \$100.00 deposit that we received in early March for a memorial service.

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The NOW team did not meet in July, but planned to meet by Zoom on August 17. Someone served by Manna lit some paper on fire and flushed it down a toilet in the Fellowship Hall, but it was put out without causing any damage. After Jim interviewed Jennifer Barcellos about the Jardin de Amor school in Guatemala, we received \$200.00 in donations, which would be sent in soon.
- **Trustees.** The Trustees have not met, but the compressor in the Fellowship Hall refrigerator broke in late July. Members of the Trustees and Finance Committee agreed to buy a new refrigerator from Home Depot, rather than spend an estimated \$1,500 to fix or replace the old compressor. The new unit cost \$2,652.09, and it was to be delivered in early August. Manna contributed \$1,000.00 of the cost, and the rest came from the Trustees' account. Members of the church family were being asked to donate toward the cost. Since we used gift cards, the scrip program netted about \$181.00.

Russell has had some problems with the riding lawn mower, but he has apparently succeeded in getting it to work again.

- **UMW:** The women still hope to have a rummage sale in the fall. UMW members assisted with Joyce O'Dell's memorial service in July, and they plan to help with the service for Suzanne Kosters on August 22.
- **Financial Report.** The total income received in July was just \$9,441.62, while the month's paid expenses were \$11,088.36. The July 31 checkbook balance was down to \$8,946.81, which means that we would have been about \$3,500 in the hole without the stimulus money that we received in April from the SBA. With the buildings shut down, our costs for utilities are lower, but not necessarily as much as we might expect. We paid PG&E \$812.56 in July, well below prior years, but our July payments to the City of Los Banos for water, sewer and trash pickup were \$926.80.
- **People in Need; Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Kathy Garrison and the families of several members of the congregation who have passed away in recent months. We may schedule a joint memorial service for those who have been unable to have their own due to the shutdown, and also some way to recognize other big events that have occurred this year, such as weddings and graduations.
- **Pastor's Report:** Jim has been dealing with insurance issues from Kathy's shoulder surgery, and they greatly appreciate those who have provided meals and support to them. The connecting Bible studies have been a good resource for him to keep up with members of the congregation.
