Administrative Council Highlights – March 2, 2021

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 with six people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Update on Church Re-Opening.** Indoor in-person worship services resume on Sunday, March 7. We will be limited to 25% of capacity, masks and 6-foot social distancing will be required, and there will be no fellowship time in the building after the service. Communion will be served, using prepackaged elements, and singing will be led from the front of the church. We believe our Internet service is now upgraded enough so we can livestream the service, but a recording will still be posted on YouTube, with a link on our website.
- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The church's phone service has been successfully re-established following the conversion from AT&T to Comcast, and the office printer also works again. New Canaan Church is joining Manna Ministries. NOW team members continue to check in on members of the church family by phone. VBS is scheduled for the week of June 21-25, hopefully in-person, although it may need to be held entirely outdoors. The home school coop is considering a return to using our facilities, perhaps as early as this spring.
- **Trustees.** We have installed five security cameras around the church facilities, and are now able to keep an eye on activities through the Internet. One camera will be moved from the Rainbow Room to the J Street side of the Fellowship Hall, where there has been quite a bit of daytime homeless activity. There is no electrical connection where we want the camera, so we will hire an electrician to make it work. We have officially given the LB Police authority to enforce no trespassing rules on our grounds. We now have the

option of contacting the police if we see anything and can't get people to cease and desist by using the built-in speakers. Some storage is built into the system for later viewing, but we don't know for sure how much.

The parsonage washing machine is still working, but it doesn't sound too healthy. A piano tuner is to come on March 3 to work on the grand piano in the Fellowship Hall. We are now ready to begin work on the parsonage fence. The next Trustees meeting will be on Tuesday, March 9.

- **UMW.** The UMW held its second Zoom meeting in February, but no meeting is scheduled for March.
- **Financial Report.** The church's financial condition still looks quite good. The February General Fund collections were \$12,176.26, and our paid expenses for the month were \$9,288.64. The checkbook balance as of February 28 was about \$8,578.08. All regular bills were paid to date, but we are still waiting for invoices for 2021 pension plan contributions, which should total roughly \$3,300.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** The SPRC will not meet in March. The walk-through of the parsonage was not done in February, but will be set up for March.
- **People in Need; Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Jean Willis, Cathie Lopez, the family of Colleen Menefee, the Matthew Patrick family, and Ted Kraynick.
- **Pastor's Report.** The planned 2020 UMC General Conference that had been delayed until September 2021 due to the pandemic has again been put off, until 2022. Due to a lack of sign-ups, the Dave Ramsey Financial Peace University course at New Beginnings Church starting March 9 has been cancelled.
