## Administrative Council Highlights – August 1, 2023

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, August 1, 2023 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The NOW Committee met on July 17 and discussed the following items: The air conditioning in the sanctuary has been fixed; a total of \$1,436.00 was donated by the VBS attendees, with this year's recipient charity being Gideons International for their Bible ministry. Pastor Ivoni has started a weekly prayer conference call on Wednesday mornings, where participants hear a devotional and share their prayer concerns and joys; seven were on the first call. She has also asked all of us to take a few minutes at noon each day to pray for our church. Bud mentioned that Gideon has lately been running the PowerPoint during on Sunday mornings. Because Kimery will be unable to put together the presentations while she recovers from surgery, Robert Cardenas has agreed to coordinate that work. The next NOW meeting is set for August 21, by Zoom.
- **Trustees.** Russ is cutting back some branches at the church property. We are still waiting for the electrician to install service so we can relocate the security camera at the Fireside Room kitchen, and also waiting for Ronny's to complete the annual certification of our backflow preventer. Because Ivoni has set regular office hours at the church, we will look into installing a doorbell at the Pastor's study, and possibly a peephole.
- **United Women in Faith.** The Women in Faith will resume meeting in September.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Things are going well with our staff

members, and the next SPRC meeting was planned for Wednesday, August 9, by Zoom. Susan was to meet with Ivoni the next day.

- **Financial Report.** The General Fund income for July was \$12,261.97, but total paid expenses were \$15,082.68, leaving a checking account balance of \$4,453.50 on July 31. There were \$3,038.46 of unpaid bills at the end of the month. Vanco has just raised their monthly fee for online giving by \$10.00, to \$39.99.
- **Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Kimery, Dan and Karen Bonillas, Wilma, Jean Bright, Eileen Sorensen, and Jean Willis.
- **Pastor's Report.** Ivoni was happy to note that she had now completed her first month here, and she expressed her appreciation for the support and help she has received. She has started meeting weekly with the revived youth group on Thursdays, but expected that schedule to change when school resumes. She has plans to offer a special blessing one Sunday each month to all those celebrating birthdays or anniversaries during the month. She mentioned that she is open to suggestions from any members of the congregation, and she encouraged everyone to join with her on her weekly prayer conference calls on Wednesday mornings at 10:00 a.m.
