Administrative Council Highlights – August 6, 2024

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, August 6, 2024 with eight people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** Bud stated that the NOW Committee had not met in July, so he had nothing to report.
- **Trustees.** It has been determined that the new ice maker cannot be easily repaired, so the manufacturer will ship us a new one, allowing us to keep the original machine for parts if we want. There was a discussion of the church lawn situation, and a number of broken sprinkler pipes are expected to be repaired very soon. Lori advised that she had not heard anything recently from the hospital, but we presume that they still want to use the Fellowship Hall kitchen for a couple of months this fall.
- **United Women in Faith.** The women will have a non-business lunch at España's on Saturday, August 10, and all women were invited.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** To date, just a few of our employees have been fingerprinted, but eventually all employees and volunteers who have dealings with children will need to be fingerprinted and registered with the state.
- **Financial Report.** Our General Fund income in July was the best since April, but it fell short of the paid expenses by roughly \$2,100. All bills were paid in full, but the checking account balance was down to \$21,800.47. We are hopeful that three future fundraisers – the Rummage Sale in September, the luau in October, and a Fall Festival Craft Fair and Dinner in November – will help significantly.

- **Upcoming Events.** The following upcoming events were discussed:
 - a. Centering Prayer Sessions – Wednesday evenings, starting August 14
 - b. Bible Reading Group – Thursday evenings, starting August 15
 - c. Church Rummage Sale – Sept. 6-7
 - d. Second Annual Luau – October 26
 - e. Fall Festival Craft Fair and Dinner – November 16
- **Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Guadalupe, Ivoni, Amanda, Howard, Foa and the Sunday School program, and Tom Kaljian for safe travels.
- **Pastor's Report.** Ivoni reported that she had recently visited Barbara Murphy in the memory care facility in Los Banos, and Donna Morris as she prepares for her second shoulder surgery. She has also made several attempts to contact June Sloan, but so far without success.
