Administrative Council Highlights – October 1, 2024

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, October 1, 2024 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** Bud stated that the NOW Committee met on September 16, and covered the following topics. Hans Younce and Jim Jones have been doing a lot of tree trimming and general cleanup on the church property. Ivoni and Foa will begin regularly providing food and drink to homeless people in our community on the second and fourth Sundays of each month. Bud still has hopes of re-establishing a men's group.
- **Trustees.** The tasks planned for a work day on Saturday, October 19 were discussed. The bathroom drain in the parsonage still needs attention, and the lawn sprinklers work only partially.
- **United Women in Faith.** Laura Scott said the women's group would gather on October 10 for an "Apple Meeting" at which all women were asked to bring something homemade from apples. They were also asked to come with a list of as many apple recipes as they could think of without resorting to the Internet. Their November 14 meeting will feature a talk on hospice services, and the annual Christmas party will be held on December 12 in the Four Seasons' recreation room.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Susan reported that the parsonage repairs had been completed. At the Charge Conference after church on October 6, with the District Superintendent presiding, one of the main agenda items is approval of Ivoni's 2025 compensation package. It will unfortunately include only a 2.6% cost of living increase.
- **Financial Report.** Our General Fund income in September was \$14,053.95, which was \$1,223.07 more than the paid expenses of \$12,830.88. The very successful rummage sale in early September made \$2,499.00 for the church and \$2,500.00 for the United Women in Faith. All invoices were current, and the checkbook balance was up slightly, to \$16,500.26.
- **Planning for Fall Festival Event.** The preliminary plans for the return of the Fall Festival on Saturday, November 16 were described, with a craft fair in the morning, and a spaghetti dinner and prize raffles in the evening. There will be two raffles: one for numerous items, and one for a big Disney prize, with a limited number of tickets costing \$10.00 each.
- **Upcoming Events.** Brief mention was made of the following upcoming events:
 - a. Charge Conference – October 6
 - b. Church work day – October 19
 - c. Fall Festival Craft Fair, Dinner, Raffle – Saturday, November 16
- **Parish Care.** Prayers were requested for Guadalupe, Susan Ramsey, Charlene Martin, and Melinda Wall.
- **Pastor's Report.** Ivoni has submitted a grant application for a new sound system for the sanctuary. There are District Union funds available to buy appliances, and perhaps the United Women in Faith can apply for some kitchen items. She felt that things were going quite well, but she has concerns over Sunday school and the youth program. She wants to start "Bring a Friend" Sundays and will soon lead a pet blessing on the church grounds. Ivoni will be away from October 10-13 to be a leader at a Walk to Emmaus weekend in Madera. She has submitted the paperwork to apply to be commissioned as an elder, and will be interviewed on October 17.
