Administrative Council Highlights – March 4, 2025

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, March 4, 2025 with seven people present. The following items were discussed:

- **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** The NOW Committee did not meet in February, but it was reported that Tawny would be working with the youth and children for the Palm Sunday service, and Kerri and Shannan were taking care of the egg hunt after the Easter Sunday service.
- **Trustees.** There was no report from the Trustees, but a church work day is scheduled for Saturday, April 12.
- **United Women in Faith.** The women will meet on March 15 for a Cupcakes and Conversation retreat.
- **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Susan has produced a flyer listing the activities scheduled for the Lenten season. She and Trustee Chair Kevin Ferreira will soon do the annual walk-through of the parsonage with Ivoni, as required by the Book of Discipline. SPRC is beginning a search for a new part-time Youth Director.
- **Financial Report.** We have transferred \$1,200 from the Designated Fund to the General Fund, to cover this year's costs for the youth program prior to departure of our Youth Director. The \$1,200 was from the \$5,000 District grant for the youth program. With the transfer, the General Fund income for February was \$11,274.37, nearly identical to the paid expenses of \$11,306.06. The checking account balance was \$5,565.48, with \$1,519.58 of unpaid bills outstanding.
- **Restructuring of Committees.** Bud said he and Ivoni had discussed a change to the committee structure, as there was a lot of redundancy in the items covered by the NOW Committee and reports made to the

Administrative Council. He suggested that NOW and the Ad Council be combined, with Gregg Rice remaining as Chair of the Finance Committee and Bud to be named Chair of the enlarged Ad Council. Gregg said he did not oppose the proposal, as he had not considered it to be a "lifetime assignment" in 1989 when he was asked to be Chair of the Ad Council. By unanimous vote, the proposed restructuring was approved.

- **Upcoming Events.** Lenten season events, including Ash Wednesday (March 5); Palm Sunday (April 13); Good Friday

(April 18), and Easter Sunday's sunrise service, worship service and egg hunt (April 20). DS Mary Maaga will preach Easter morning but Ivoni will be present. Starting March 9, Foa and Lori will head up a program to feed the homeless on the second and fourth Sundays of each month. Other upcoming dates include: April 12 – Church work day; June 23-27 – VBS; June 27-30 – Annual Conference in Sacramento; September 5-6 – Rummage sale. We have officially withdrawn our application for a fireworks booth this year.

- **Parish Care; People in Need of Prayer.** Prayers were requested for Charlene Martin, June Sloan, Donna Morris, Kimery, Dan and Karen Bonillas, Melissa Jones, Dan Wilson, Diane Moon, Barbara Murphy, Laura's father-in-law Phil Scott, Cathie's mother-in-law Barbara Lopez, and Fay Davis.

- **Pastor's Report.** We are now having the choir personnel sing a few praise songs or hymns prior to 10:00 on Sunday

mornings. Ivoni is considering other changes to our praise and worship program. She reported that the Free Methodist Church will be joining in our March 23 service. Susan Younce will be coming up with fun activities for the youth once a month. Otherwise, Ivoni is concentrating on Easter season events.
