Dear Family of United Methodist Church of Los Banos:



"Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return".

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, a season of forty days (minus Sundays) during which we prepare ourselves for the events of Holy Week and Easter. We start the journey of Lent with confession, pardon, and the imposition of ashes, a reminder of our mortality. Though this can often feel like a serious service, Psalm 51:1 says, “Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love.” We begin Lent with the reminder that God’s love is steadfast—it never fails. God’s love is like a light that guides us home, ignites our bones, and fixes us, putting us back together for relationship with God and one another.

Please pray this prayer of confession with your family or someone on March 5th, the Ash Wednesday, beginning of Lent. We will follow the Lent season of forty days 40 days with the “The Purpose of Driven Life” by Rich Warren. Contact Pastor ‘Ivoni for details.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION (*inspired by Psalm 51*)

On this first day of Lent we pause, look within, and examine our consciousness.

Have mercy on us, O God, according to your steadfast love.

That gift is given to us again, here and now. Be encouraged. **Amen.**

There will be a silent service in the sanctuary as well. Please come let us pray and worship our God and celebrate the everlasting love God has given us each day of our lives.

Administrative Council Highlights – February 4, 2025

The Ad Council met by Zoom conference on Tuesday, February 4, 2025 with six people present. The following items were discussed:

• **Nurture, Outreach and Witness (NOW).** There was a good turnout for the January 19 planning meeting, and we came up with about 15 ideas for new activities. The list was sent out by email, in *The Vine* and passed out on Sunday morning, and will be reviewed over the next few months. The Worship Committee is considering forming a Praise Team. It was agreed to take a survey about whether we should do the fireworks booth, and to get commitments to work in the booth if we proceed. Ivoli has plans for fasting, prayers, and Bible readings. There was talk about a summer conference for youth. A new AA group starts meeting soon in one of our classrooms. Trees are being trimmed, and the Free Methodist church is renting our sanctuary from 1pm-5pm on Sundays. Ivoli plans to meet soon about feeding the homeless. In December, the women sent food and gifts to a family in need, and took blankets to the nearby rest home. Shannan and Kerri will meet in the next month or so with VBS leaders. It was reported that the Youth scavenger hunt went really well.

• **Trustees.** Kevin Ferreira is the new Chair of the Board of Trustees. Jim and Melissa Jones have been doing a great job cleaning out the attic. The trustees will be meeting

each month on the second Tuesday mostly on Zoom, but in person once a quarter.

• **United Women in Faith.** The women will meet February 13 for a Valentine's card making craft, and on March 15 for a Cupcakes and Conversation retreat.

• **Staff-Parish Relations Committee.** Kathy will no longer be working with the youth. SPRC will start looking for a new Youth Director. As required by the Book of

Discipline, the Chair of SPRC and the Chair of Trustees are to do a walkthrough of the parsonage each year. Kevin, Ivoli and Susan will be setting up a time for this to take place.

• **Financial Report.** Our January income of \$12,072.16 was fairly good, but paid expenses were \$17,810.72, reducing the General Fund checking account from \$11,404.93 to \$5,666.37. The unusually high amount of payments involved about \$4,800 of one-time annual bills, including the music copyright license fee, software upgrade and license, a large down payment for our insurance renewal, and repair of an air conditioning unit in the classroom wing.

• **Pastor's Report.** Pastor Ivoli got no response to the Membership Class, so will contact people about it. A new Social Justice Committee plans to take food to the homeless on the second and fourth Sundays of the month. The New Year Fasting and Reading the Bible starts on February 15.

• **Upcoming Events.** Brief mention was made of the following upcoming events:

a. 2025 is the 150th Anniversary of Los Banos UMC. A committee will start making plans for this event.

b. **February 15** – New Year Fasting and Reading the Bible begins.

c. **March 5** – Ash Wednesday Drive through 7AM – 9AM

d. **March 5** – Ash Wednesday Quiet Time 11AM - 1PM & 5PM - 7PM

e. **June 23 - 27** – VBS week.
